Charges:

The charge of £100 per unit is levied by the Museum.

One unit is:

- a small finds box
- a bulk finds box
- a large unboxed object
- a documentary Archive box
- a roll of documents/ drawings

These charges will take effect from the issue of this document and be applicable to all archaeological projects generated after 1st April 2017. In addition, the unit price (£100) will increase by £10 year on year to be reviewed during the documents yearly review. The charge applicable will be calculated by current charges at the date of deposition, not the date of notification.

All finds should be marked with an identifying site code and packaged appropriately in acid free boxes with copper staples or Stewart boxes where appropriate.

All paper archive should be packaged in acid free boxes and wallets.

Digital images on compact disc are welcome but must be accompanied by hard copy prints.

Failure to comply with this information will result in depositing units having additional charges added to their invoice to cover the cost of supplying appropriate archival quality packaging.
